~~If a Pre-determined Allocation (PDA) for the swing or rank methodology is received without an approval from the swing or lowest ranked party, then it is not considered a valid PDA and allocation defaults to pro-rata.~~

Amended 2.3.H.1

On monthly allocating Transportation Service Providers (TSPs), at locations where the Swing or Rank Allocation Method is employed by a TSP, any Service Requester (SR) that has been designated by an Operator as the Swing party or the lowest ranked SR must be notified by the TSP prior to gas flow of its proposed status. Notification should be via e-mail or other electronic method, fax, or telephone. Absent communication from the SR or the Operator to the TSP to the contrary, such designation should be considered effective as of gas flow.
