

Work Paper submitted by Skipping Stone for R96115

- S1: The purpose of the Response to Withdrawal Upload is to inform the party sending the Withdrawal Upload that either: a) there is an error in the Withdrawal Upload which prevents the withdrawal from being considered effective; or, b) the withdrawal can be considered to be effective.
- S2: When a Transportation Service Provider (TSP) sends a Response to Withdrawal Upload which communicates that the Withdrawal Upload communication was not considered to be effective, it should provide the receiver with at least one accurate reason for the withdrawal not having been considered effective by the TSP .
- S3: A Response to a Withdrawal Upload which is responding with respect to a Withdrawal Upload seeking to withdraw a bid, should be received by the sender of the Withdrawal Upload within 15 minutes of the receipt by the Transportation Service Provider (TSP) of same. A Response to a Withdrawal Upload which is responding with respect to a Withdrawal Upload seeking to withdraw an offer, should be received by the sender of the Withdrawal Upload within 30 minutes of the receipt by the TSP of same.
