

Rae: On behalf of CIG, I would like to submit the following comments on the draft EDM Manual. I have indicated the Adobe pdf page number to assist you in locating the specific source of my comments. Some of these are format related and some are of a more substantive nature:

Format Issues:

1. Page 17 of the listing of the standards (pdf page 25): the word "News" is not aligned correctly with the rest of the list.
2. Page 1, Related Standards (pdf page 34), third paragraph: the footnote number after D-U-N-S is not a numeral "1".
3. Appendix C (pdf page 96): the word "Windows 95" is not aligned correctly with the rest of the list.

Substantive Issues:

1. Version Notes are missing.
2. pdf page 11, paragraph 2 under In-house Implementation: In the second sentence, strike the word "to" between the words "parties" and "fully" to make this sentence grammatically correct.
3. Compare Standards 4.3.46 and 4.3.65 (on pdf pages 27 and 29 respectively). The first sentence of 4.3.46 appears to be essentially duplicative of the language in 4.3.65. (This issue should probably have been raised during initial EC consideration of these standards prior to Member ratification.)
4. Appendix C, (pdf page 95): the browser versions are incorrect and need to be corrected to reflect Netscape v4.06 and Explorer v4.0 service pack 1. This is the issue raised by Theresa Hess during the draft manual review conference calls.
5. Appendix D, (pdf page 98), in footnote 2, correct spelling of Apple Computers.

Thanks for the opportunity to comment and thanks, too, for the substantial work you've put into this effort.
