**Description:** Add data element "Model Type" to Shipper Imbalance data set.  
**Task Force Recommendation:** Modify data set to add data element as requested

**Subcommittee Comments:** The recommendation contains the proposed revision for the data dictionary to be to add the "Model Type" data element with a definition of "This field identifies the type of nomination structure being used. Types are: Pathed and Non-Pathed." The Technical Subcommittee is questioning whether or not the Pathed Non-Threaded model type should be added to the definition also.

**Description:** Add data element "UPPD Level Error/Warning ID" to the UPPD Validation data set.  
**Task Force Recommendation:** Modify data set to add data element as requested

**Subcommittee Comments:** The addition of a data element is not necessary to accomplish what is requested. A comment can be added to the UPPD PO1 ANSI field (PO101) which states "This value should be returned in the G843UDVL PO101 when errors or warnings exist." A comment would also be added to the UPPD Validation ANSI field (PO101) which states "An echo of G840UDOF PO101." This same type of thing is accomplished in the current implementation of the PDA Quick Response from the Flowing Gas Related Standards.
