**REQUEST #    PROPOSED STANDARD OR MODIFICATION**

R96034            Modify GISB Standard 2.3.16 to include a new mutually agreed, allocation methodology "Operator Provided Quantity". The Allocation transaction, GISB Standard 2.4.4, and PDA transaction, GISB Standard 2.4.1, would also need to be modified to allow for the new method.

R96097            The following codes should be valid codes for the Transaction Status Code in GISB Standard 1.4.2, Nomination Quick Response, and all other Transaction Status Codes deleted:

AE -    Errors or warnings occurred in the Transaction. Some Nominations may be accepted and some may be rejected.

AT -    The entire Transaction and all Nominations were accepted.

RD -    The entire Transaction was rejected due to header level errors.

R96131 Modify implementation guides text in the Flowing Gas Standards Manuals for the the Allocation Data Set, GISB Standard 2.4.2, and the Predetermined Allocation Data Set, GISB Standard 2.4.1 to reflect that at an allocation point, many different parties representing different roles can exist. Roles can included transporter, shipper, producer, operator, end user, LDC, and third party service provider. Each of these parties can and usually do have different needs and uses for allocation information.

R97001 Modify the "Assigned Line Number" specified in the first LX occurrence of the Data Element Cross Reference of GISB Standard 3.4.1, Transportation/Sales Invoice, to the name of the segment itself, which is "Assigned Number".

R97023 The documents identified in GISB Standard 4.3.6 should be made available in HTML and/or RTF format.
