In the posting dated December 16, 1996, file name COR1218B.PDF, request R96022 was listed for comments by 12/27/96 and E.C. vote on 1/9/97. This request involves the conversion of 8 principles (1.1.1; 1.1.4; 1.1.7; 3.1.2; 4.1.5; 4.1.6; 4.1.7 and 4.1.8) to standards. The E.C. has not discussed this request, except for the November 1996 E.C. meeting at which it was assigned to Group 6 - Other and given a status code of "2 (not urgent). To my knowledge, this request has not been discussed by any subcommittee or task force. It appears that this request was inadvertently put on the list as being ready for industry comment and E.C. vote. Due to the lack of discussion and evaluation, such request is unsupportable at this time. Further, WINGS strongly opposes the conversion of any principle to a standard until after the 143 standards currently slated for implemented in 1997 have been in effectively put in place.
