

## Report to GISB Executive Committee May 20 1999

### Status of Version 1.4 Implementation Guide publication

Due Date: August 31, 1999

- 1 August 31 books will include all fully staffed items approved by the Executive Committee through July 15, 1999. (This means that Title Transfer Tracking standards will not be included )
- 2 Code values from R97111 approved and ratified will be included in a new set of tables. These tables, consisting of the Code Name, Description and *Definition* will appear with each data set in the implementation guide immediately following the data dictionary.
- 3 The documents are being converted from WordPerfect to Word and will be filed and distributed in .PDF format.
- 4 The EDM book updates consist of the new standards resulting from EII. There is a new request submitted by Group 8760 to define the corresponding changes to the book that resulted from the EII process. Resolution of this request could affect the publication value and/or date of the EDM book.
- 5 The Related Standards portion of the books (which currently contains references to DRNs, D-U-N-S, ANSI, etc. Will be combined to make a single Related Standards section that will appear in all books.
- 6 Related to item 5, there has been discussion that the ANSI portion of the Related Standards section needs to describe the GISB usage of the ISA and GS segments. We will consult with DISA to see if there is an explanation of these segments that is generally available to incorporate into the Related Standards section. If there is not, then we will compose a description for this section.
