Re: Request for progress report on Imbalance Netting & Trading

Date: August 10, 2000

In response to the GISB Executive Committee request for a progress report on the status of the work regarding Imbalance Netting & Trading, the Expedited Data Development Subcommittee (EDD) reports that their work is complete. EDD's work product is ready for delivery to the Technical Subcommittee for development of EDI mapping and corresponding documentation.

The tasks completed by EDD are listed below:

- I. Revisions have been made to the following in the Flowing Gas Standards book:
 - A. Executive Summary
 - B. Business Process and Practices
- II. The following datasets have been defined:
 - A. Authorization to Post Imbalances
 - B. Posted Imbalances Download
 - C. Request for Imbalance Trade
 - D. Request for Imbalance Trade Quick Response
 - E. Withdrawal of Request for Imbalance Trade
 - F. Request for Confirmation of Imbalance Trade
 - G. Imbalance Trade Confirmation
 - H. Imbalance Trade Notification
- III. For each of the above datasets, the following has been completed:
 - A. Technical Implementation of Business Process (TIBP)
 - B. Data Dictionary
 - C. Data Element Abbreviations
 - D. Data Hierarchy
 - E. Data Groupings
 - F. EBB, EDI and Flat File Data Element Usages
 - G. Code Values Dictionaries
 - H. Sample Paper Transaction
- IV. EDD was instructed by the Imbalance Subcommittee not to develop ordering of data elements for EBB display. EDD sent the following issue to the Imbalance Subcommittee for resolution:

“EDD requests the Imbalance Subcommittee to review the existing business standards for possible revisions related to the Imbalance Netting / Trading data sets on Web sites. Some examples are: GISB Standard Nos. 2.3.32, 4.3.42, 4.3.54, and 4.3.75.”
