BGE's only comment is that the notice requirements in 10.2 and 10.3 appear to be inconsistent. Deleting the phrase "without prior notice" in the last line of 10.2 would eliminate that inconsistency. With this revision, 10.2 would incorporate, by reference to 10.3, the manner in which the non-defaulting party communicates to the defaulting party of its intent to exercise its rights under 10.2.
