- The Agenda was adopted as presented.

- Minutes from April 24, 2001 FTTF meeting were adopted with the following corrections:
 - Page 1
 - 2nd bullet under Sandia Issue 7.1.11 – ‘this ports’ was changed to ‘these ports’
 - added the clause ‘due to their existing use’ to the end of the 1st bullet under the FTTF’s recommendation for issue 7.1.11
 - Page 2
 - No changes
 - Page 3
 - Changed the 2nd major bullet under ‘Annual Review...’ to ‘Client for Informational Posting Website’
 - Removed the space from ‘443’ in the 4th major bullet under ‘Annual Review...’
 - Under the bullet ‘SSL to port 443’, changed to read ‘... as well as HTTP and move port 443 up.’
 - Changes to attachment to Minutes – ‘Minimums and Versions’
 - Page 1
 - Changed SHTTP to HTTPS
 - In first sentence of 2nd full paragraph, removed ‘and SMTP’, since SMTP is not listed with the ports
 - Page 2
 - Changed SHTTP to HTTPS
 - Page 6
 - Added Windows ME and LINUX to the list of suggested Operating Systems.

- We will suggest to EDM that companies be notified that when they rewrite batch browsers, that they keep in mind the HTTP 1.1 change being suggested for the next publication.
