**Things to Know**

Calgary is a great bargain for US visitors. The Canadian Dollar is at an all time low so you will get a very good exchange rate. You will get approximately \$1.50 CDN for \$1.00 US. To convert Canadian prices to US, multiply by .67 for an approximation. This may be the lowest priced business trip you have ever taken.

When you land in Calgary you will have to clear Canadian Customs and Immigration. You will require proof of citizenship. You should bring either a passport or your birth certificate and picture id. Your drivers license alone is not acceptable. Immigration may question you on the type of work you will be doing in Canada but just explain that you are only attending meetings.
