Todd,

At the end of the last meeting, one of the discussion points under Item 1.3 of the Issues List was left open. The group was trying to characterize the differences between electric and gas dispatch. I believe the feeling among some in the WEQ/WGQ groups was that the wording for electric dispatch needed some amplification. The items now reads: "Electric scheduling follows contractual commitments but is impacted by economic and real time events (Proposed Addition)"

Here's a suggested replacement of the wording for the item.

Electric dispatch is subject to contractual commitments but is also impacted by:

- o Availability of prescheduled generation assets
- o Congestion at bottlenecks on the transmission system
- o Availability of incremental/decremental energy at various points in the transmission system and
- o The economic value of real time incremental/decremental energy at various points in the transmission system
