Preparer ID	The name and address of the business party preparing the report.	M	
Production Period	The production period month and year for which the Authorized Imbalance Quantity is being requested.	M	
Rate Schedule	A representation of the rate schedule that is the same as the Transportation Service Provider's tariff abbreviation (if any) for the rate schedule under which service is being provided.	C	Depends on level of authorization
Service Requester	Identifies the party requesting the service, or its agent.	M	
Service Requester Contract	This is the contract under which the service is being requested.	C	Depends on level of authorization
Statement Date/Time	Date and time the statement was produced.	M
