Production Period	The production period month and year for which the Authorized Imbalance Quantity is being requested.	M	
Rate Schedule	A representation of the rate schedule that is the same as the Transportation Service Provider's tariff abbreviation (if any) for the rate schedule under which service is being provided.	C	Based on the level at which imbalances are maintained.
Service Requester	Identifies the party requesting the service.	M	
Service Requester Agent	Identifies the agent of the Service Requester.	C	Mandatory when present in the Upload of Request for Download of Posted Datasets.
