#### Standard x.4.z Authorized Imbalances Download

Business Name	Definition	Usage	Condition
Authorized Imbalance Quantity	The authorized imbalance quantity which occurred during an imbalance period, or the authorized imbalance quantity as of the end of an imbalance period. This quantity may be a portion of, or all of, the total imbalance.	M	
Contact Person	The name and telephone number of the contact for questions regarding the statement information.	M	
Imbalance Period	The month and year during which the imbalance occurred or the cumulative imbalance is reported.	M	
Imbalance Type	Identifies the specific type of imbalance trading transaction.	BC	Based on the Transportation Service Provider's method of accounting for imbalances.
Operational Impact Area	A Transportation Service Provider's designation of the largest possible area(s) on its system in which imbalances have a similar operational effect.	M	
Rate Schedule	A representation of the rate schedule that is the same as the Transportation Service Provider's tariff abbreviation (if any) for the rate schedule under which service is being provided.	BC	Based on the Transportation Service Provider's method of accounting for imbalances.
Service Requester*	Identifies the party requesting the service, or their agent.	M	
Service Requester Contract	This is the contract under which service is being requested.	BC	Based on the Transportation Service Provider's method of accounting for imbalances.
Statement Date/Time	Date and time the statement was produced.	M	
Statement Recipient ID	The intended user of the statement.	M	
Transportation Service Provider*	Identifies the party providing the requested service.	M	
Zone Identifier	The transporter's geographic zone identification.	BC	Based on the
