

Tina Patton of Boeing provided the following information about the IR meeting in Seattle:

The Information Requirements meeting will be held at Boeing's South Park office location, at 1420 South Trenton Street, Seattle, where my new office is located (see attached map). I will meet everybody at the lobby (well actually outside the lobby) of the 15-20 building and escort them to the meeting room. We have no guards, gates, or receptionists here, but the doors are access controlled. I will try to provide access cards based on a list of regular meeting attendees from the IR Chair.

There are no business hotels near the meeting site. However, since the South Park complex is just a couple of miles north of the Museum of Flight, any of the airport hotels would be convenient. Or downtown Seattle is just a short ride away if you prefer to stay downtown. For your convenience, I have provided below a list of both downtown and airport hotels.
