Re: Comments Regarding R02002 and 2002 Annual Plan Item 10 - Order 587-N
Recommendation 2

The subject proposed standards and principles are the result of careful and deliberate work by the WGQ BPS and we have no issues with the content or direction of the proposals.

We would, however, offer one clarifying suggestion. In Proposed Standard 5.3.z12, reference is made to a TSP's "recall notification specification." The proposed standard then goes on to explain the two recall options that can be selected by the TSP (and presumably are contained in the "recall notification specification").

Unfortunately, proposed standard 5.3.z12 is the only place in the proposed standards the "recall notification specification" is mentioned. Nowhere (in the proposed standards or in existing WGQ standards) is the document defined or otherwise referenced.

Therefore, for clarification, we proposed the following revision to proposed standard 5.3.z12:

5.3.z12 Proposed Standard

For the recall notification provided to the Transportation Service Provider (TSP), ~~the quantity should conform to the TSP's capacity recall notification specification.~~ ~~¶~~ the TSP's Tariff should specify whether the quantity should be expressed in terms of

- a) total released capacity entitlements or
- b) adjusted total released capacity entitlements based upon the Elapsed Prorata Capacity.

The capacity entitlements resulting from the use of either a) or b) should be the same.
