

**Internet “Look and Feel” Team
Additional Proposed Standards by ECT**

Passed Standard 14:

- A. The “Notices” category (as shown on the left) should expand to a list of subcategories (on the left) when clicked; there is no display requirement on the right. Each subsequent level of sub-category, would expand to display (also on the left) the associated sub-subcategories. When clicked, each of these subcategories and sub-subcategories within them should display a list of notices, for that category (sub or sub-sub) on the right. Within this standard, the left refers to the navigational area and the right refers to the content area.
- B. For the subcategories of Notices the first 5 column Headings should be notice type, posted date/time, effective date/time (and notice end/time where applicable), notice identifier (optional*), and subject, with the list sorted in reverse chronological order by posted date/time. When used as a reference the Notice Identifier should be displayed.

Proposed Standard 14C:

The sub-subcategories under the Notice subcategories of critical and non-critical should be

1. ***Capacity Constraint***
2. ***Capacity Discount***
3. ***Curtailement***
4. ***Force Majeure***
5. ***Maintenance***
6. ***Operational Flow Order***
7. ***Press Release, Company News or Phone List***
8. ***Other***

Passed Standard 24A:

The following categories and subcategories should be downloadable in tab-delimited ASCII format:
Capacity Allocation Log

Operationally Available Capacity
Unsubscribed Capacity
Index of Customer

Proposed Standard 24B:

These files should be downloadable in the format set forth in Sections 1, 2, and 5 of the "Instruction Manual for Electronic Filing of the Index of Customers" as issued in Order No.581, Docket No. RM95-4-000, issued February 29, 1996.

Proposed Standard 25:

A sixth category called "Download" should be added to Informational Postings after the Tariff category. When clicked on, download should open a page containing links to all downloadable documents.

Note: Tariff would also be included.

Proposed Standard 26:

The "Operational Available Capacity" and "Unsubscribed Capacity" file for download should include the following columns in this order:

***Point Common Code
Point Description
Segment Zone Name
Location Quantity Type
Available Quantity
Available Capacity Effective Date/Time
Available Capacity End Date/Time
Posting Date/Time***

Proposed Standard 27:

The "Capacity Allocation Log" file for download should include the following columns in this order:

***Shipper (Affiliated Marketer)
Contract Number
Relevant Date***

The data should be sorted by Relevant Date in chronological order.
