

GISB Notices Committee Workpaper

In response to Enron Capital and Trade's Workpaper:

Direct Notification to Customer's URL: ECT is correct that this was included in Order 587-G and not addressed in the proposed standards. ECT states a new GISB data set for notices is needed for direct communication to the customer's URL. If this is true (and I'm not technically competent enough to support or oppose that comment), there are two ways to approach creating a new data set - simple and detailed. A simple data set would contain minimal information and used primarily to alert the customer that an event (bump, OFO, critical notice) has occurred and allow the customer to then go to the TSP's web site to get more specific details. The detailed approach would create a very comprehensive data set to provide very specific information about the event. Since the type of notices are very different and TSPs have unique needs and tariff requirements concerning OFOs and Critical Notices, I believe the simple approach will better serve the industry. This approach will allow for quicker completion of the committee's work meaning the solution is available to the industry sooner rather than later. Also since the customer will have access to the detailed information through the Internet, information can be obtained in an easy and timely manner. Consistent with the simple approach, the following is a proposed data dictionary for the Notices data set.

Business Name	Definition	Usage	Condition
Notice Recipient *	The party being notified.	M	
Notice Preparer *	The party issuing the notice.	M	
Notice Preparer's URL	Internet address to find additional information concerning the notice.	M	
Notice Type	Identifies the type of notice being provided.	M	Codes: Bump, OFO, Critical Notice
Notice Effective Date/Time	Date/time that the notice becomes effective.	M	
Notice Time Stamp	Date and time when data left control of the Notice Preparer.	M
