002	2/12/2003	<p><b>gisb-acknowledgement-receipt:</b> The format of the acknowledgement is proposed to include a time-zone. This format change requires the creation of a new "named" value.</p>	Open	
003	2/12/2003	<p><b>transaction-set string length:</b>            The character length was defined by the NAESB WGQ standards for abbreviating transaction sets. NAESB REQ has not yet identified transaction sets. Upon the creation of a standard naming convention for NAESB REQ transaction sets, the transaction-set string length will be determined.</p>	Open	
004	2/12/2003	<p><b>HTTP Head Method:</b> Awaiting NAESB WGQ interpretation on the use of HTTP HEAD method and the use of the POST method.</p>	Hold	<p>See 03001. 006	2/12/2003	<b>Unknown Issue:</b> Possibly reference to multi-part post	Hold	Waiting for someone who remembers the issue to step forward. If no one identifies the issue in the next meeting, the issue will be closed.
007	2/12/2003	<b>Reference to Standard:</b> Ultimately, the NAESB REQ will adopt new standards and the numbering scheme will change.	Open	
008	2/12/2003	<b>Trading Partner Agreement:</b> The NAESB REQ has not adopted a standard TPA.	Open	
009	2/13/2003	<b>Appendices:</b> The letters corresponding to the Appendices may change based on the Appendices required in the REQ EDM Manual.	Open	
010	2/13/2003	<b>timestamp:</b> What is the effect of daylight savings time on the timestamp? Does the use of daylight savings time affect timestamps across time zones?	Open	A standard calculation to determine the delta between the client and server needs to be created.  Issue also includes the formatting of the timestamp in example code.
011	2/13/2003	<b>PGP/OpenPGP:</b> What descriptive text is allowed to identify PGP keys? Should the descriptive text be limited in some way? The WGQ EDM manual originally read that a "human-readable" company name be returned, but in actuality, companies use DUNS numbers company names, and dates. 012	2/13/2003	<b>UserName/PWD use at Clearinghouse level:</b> A clearinghouse has the ability to represent many trading partners in a transaction. Clearinghouses are requesting a single username and password for website access. Guidelines indicate that each trading partner be assigned their own password at each website.	Open	Participants are asked to check into this issue with their respective companies. The concern is that a single username and password will provide access for multiple trading partners at a web site.
013	2/13/2003	<b>Testing:</b> How will the code examples to be published in the REQ EDM Manual be tested prior to publication?	Open	
014	2/13/2003	<b>Error Notification:</b> TEIS must develop its own error notification type to replace gisb-error-notification	Open	There is an omission in the NAESB WGQ EDM manual. Report type "gisb-error-notification" is not specifically defined, but is used in the examples.
015	2/13/2003	<b>Checklist of Testing Steps:</b> A testing checklist is being developed by Debbie McKeever. This section, "Checklist of Testing Steps" was not reviewed in lieu of the work being done by Debbie on "Standardizing Market Testing"	Open	Question: Should testing be mandatory.
016	2/13/2003	<b>EEDM109:</b> What is the purpose of the error message? What does the "parameter string" reference.	Open	
017	2/13/2003	<b>EEDM701, EEDM702, EEDM703:</b> Recommendation to talk to WGQ EDM to determine the purpose of the error messages.	Open
