GENERAL

CONCEPTS REVIEW:

- AI) Concept of limiting the “scheduled quantities document” for Intraday activity to just the changed elements.

Previous BPS discussions have covered this ground, and the point was made that for simplicity and clarity, the totality of data should be sent each time.

However, the issue of the need to indicate changes to Shippers arises in the send-all case. Also, if nothing changes at all during intraday, “send-all” option means redundantly sends data at each intraday interval.

VOTE: Whether to require a “send-all” data each time or send “changes only”.

Also, how to roll continuous and contiguous reporting into this requirement also needs to be covered.

AI.1) APPEND concept to AI: Senders are not obligated to send intraday Scheduled Quantities reports to those shippers/operators without intraday activity.
Ask for descensions: none heard. ADD CONCEPT in Language attempt.
