1.3.10 recommended strike:

Concept in this standard is superseded by 1.3.2 proposals, and actually inflicts contradiction to the overall picture.

Deleting this standard will remove contradictions that 1.3.10 gives, but throws out the useful 4 hour flow dictates being used by Tennessee, for the non-grid activity they are conducting (exceeding the standard). Furthermore, Tennessee tariff contains the 4 hour language as a result of this standard – removing the standard removes the underlying support for their tariff provision. Need new language that removes contradictions but keeps 4 hour concept.

Hold vote until we can get some language worked up for the next session.

However, since this brings about a crisis of scope for the committee. We generally can't include what to do for "exceeds the standards" since that means it becomes a standard itself. Where do we draw the line on what we are to include? It is a question for the EC.

Ultimately, Tennessee rescinded its objection to striking the proposal, so a vote was taken:

NEW: S.17 – language as proposed (formerly part of 1.3.12):

Continuous pipelines receiving intra-day nominations requiring grid-wide synchronization should hold those nominations for processing until the intended grid-wide nomination cycle (refer to 1.3.2 for minimum grid synchronization times).

Transwestern proposed added language:

However it is understood that TSP is not required to hold capacity until the standards nomination timelines.

Reworked language attempt:

For intraday nominations processed outside the standard nomination timelines which cannot be similarly confirmed, should be held for processing until the next standard nomination cycle. However it is understood that the TSP is not required to hold capacity for this nom until the next standard nomination cycle.

Hold vote until we can get some language worked up for the next session.
