Flights/Travel: **Tulsa, OK** – 1-2 hour drive to Ponca City (easiest from Houston)

Drive: From the airport, follow signs going towards downtown (Not Joplin). Take Hwy 244 for approximately 10 miles to US 6. Stay on US 64 for 24 miles until you reach the Cimmaron Turnpike west for 46 miles. Turn north on US HWY 177 for 21 miles. At this point Hwy 177 turns into Hwy 77 a few miles outside of Ponca City. At the stop sign be sure you go straight. Do not follow the signs for Hwy 177. (104 miles)

Wichita, KS – 1-2 hour drive to Ponca City

Drive: Take I-35 south, turn east on US 60 (90 miles)

Oklahoma City, OK – 1-2 hour drive to Ponca City

Drive: Take I-35 north, turn east on US 60 (106 miles)

Once in Ponca City, stay on Business 77 (14th Street). (US 60 and Cimmaron Turnpike intersect with US 77.) Turn east on Lake Road (right) then take an immediate left behind the Pioneer Woman Statue (Monument Road). Follow signs to the Estate Gates. (Also, look for the millions of fireflies along this street!) **For easy-to-read directions complete with maps, go to www.mapquest.com.**
