C. Issues Identified by the TTT PT Task Force

1. Buy/Sell transaction chain can result in different conclusions. This may indicate a need to address the issue through: a) data sets or b) order of processing conventions.
2. Some groups constructed their transaction flow diagrams including both physical and nonphysical title transfer. We need to differentiate between the physical and the nonphysical in the appropriate cases.
3. What is the convention at the Interconnects concerning who should nominate the title transfer. Should it be the upstream, downstream or both. How should the model deal with parties who are only in the middle?
4. Is the task force correct in seeing only the gross energy value units? Units in and units out of a transfer (title or physical) point may be differentiated due to service rights u/s and d/s; paper versus physical, path model u/s and d/s; etc. The base case may be a great deal more complicated than we have assumed.
5. Should we apply each of the three nomination models (path, non-path, path non-threaded) to each case?
6. Quantity in must equal quantity out for TTTSP's?
7. Should TTTSP's handle intraday nominations and if so, how efficient is each Case in terms of meeting the intraday requirements.
8. What is the effect of bumping, no bumping determinations on the title transfer model?
9. GISB should consider the examples set by other industries, such as the finished goods industry, air travel and financial markets.
10. How well does each of the Cases work within the existing GISB standard nomination timeline?
11. Do TTTSP's act the same as TSP's /point operators in communication of nomination data? (For instance, do TTTSP's obtain DRN's).
