

**Results from the June 20/21 NAESB WEQ Meeting
Critical to Today's Smaller Industry Group Meeting
June 27, 2002**

- Industry participants voted 120 to 21 for an NRECA proposed motion, seconded by EPSA, to require a confirming vote on Wholesale Electric Quadrant (WEQ) structures and procedures only after the segments, segment definitions, sub segments and procedures are determined by a straw vote of the entire industry participants group.

- The industry participants also voted 66 to 0 (with no dissenting telephone votes) to adopt the following principles to guide subsegment determination:
 - No single business interest can by itself pass a standard
 - All appropriate interests are represented
 - No subsegment may alone block action

- The industry representatives also agreed to hold an industry – only caucus of all industry interests to develop a strawman for segment sub segments prior to the next NAESB meeting in Wilmington, Delaware on July 9 &10. The caucus meeting will be hosted by FERC on June 27th from 10:00am – 5:00pm. Each industry interest to be represented by 5/6 attendees and the sub segment strawman developed – if any – to be sent to NAESB by July 2nd for subsequent transmittal to all industry representatives for discussion by the entire group at the Wilmington meeting.
