Duke Energy finds that this Scope Document in need of significant additional refinement and detail before specific meaningful edits and comment can be made to the document.

More specifically, Duke Energy has difficulty obtaining from the words/phases in the document any logical distinction between tasks that should presumably be performed by the NERC Coordination Operations Standard versus those of some conceptual NAESB Coordination Operations Business Practices Standard. If a logical distinction can not be identified, what is the purpose of the separation effort?

Duke Energy suspects there are probably some important standardizing business practices that should support NERC's reliability rules going forward, but this assumption is not supported by any words, or explanations contained in this brief scope document.
