General Topic Areas for WEQ Standards Development Activity	Completion Date	Subcommittee Assignment
<p>PREAMBLE: Restore Confidence in the Power Industry</p> <p>The WEQ recognizes the important role that developing fair, efficient and effective business practice standards will have in restoring and maintaining confidence in the electric power industry.</p>		
<p>1. Develop Relationships with Industry Standards & Technical Groups</p> <p>Coordinate activities as appropriate with industry standards and technical groups, including NERC, EPRI and the ESC/OS. Follow up on the development of the coordination MOU presently being negotiated by NERC/NAESB representatives by, among other things, reviewing and finalizing MOU implementation details.</p>		
<p>2. Revise the WEQ Procedures Bylaws Addendum</p> <p>Add detail to the existing WEQ Procedures Bylaws.</p>		
<p>3. Review and Comment on Ongoing NERC SARs Process</p> <p>Through the coordination process or other appropriate means, review and develop business practice standards as necessary to supplement and support reliability standards already under development in the NERC SARs process.</p>		
<p>4. OASIS Framework</p> <p>Review and assess existing work of the ESC and OSC to identify possible role for WEQ on OASIS-related matters.</p>		

<p>5. Develop SMD Standards and Model Business Practices</p> <p>Develop standards and model business practices in accordance with FERC orders and directions issued in the SMD docket (RM01-12-000) or otherwise.</p> <p>Respond to FERC inquiries pertaining to business practice standard development and keep FERC informed on the nature and effectiveness of coordination activities with other standard setting organizations.</p>		
<p>6. Identify Market/System Operation Activities that Should be Standardized</p> <p>Solicit input from WEQ members to identify issue list reflecting standards to be developed based on existing FERC orders, particularly FERC Orders 888 and 2000.</p>
