

**Industry comments recommended to be incorporated into posted documents**

1. Replace User's Guide Appendix B-2 with completed Appendix B-2 Timeline submitted by Keith Sappenfield.
2. Replace User's Guide's Appendices A-1, A-2, A-3, B-1 and B-3 Timelines that are updated to reflect consistent formats and word usage. No change in content. The Timelines were submitted by Keith Sappenfield.
3. Replace question marks (?) under "Elections" on Page 1 of the CSA with check boxes. Comment was submitted by Keith Sappenfield.
4. Under Option A and Option B of the CSA reword Paragraph 5 (b) (iii) to read in part as follows:  
"no Early Termination Date has occurred or been designated by the Secured Party for which there exist any unsatisfied payment obligation under the Base Contract, the Pledging Party may substitute for existing Posted Collateral new Eligible Collateral of equal or greater Value..."  
This comment was submitted by Mike Shepard corrects a reference in these provisions.
5. Under Purpose on Page 4 of the CSA User's Guide rewrite the beginning of the second sentence labeled with a number (1.) as follows:  
"The CSA is probably not needed when Local Distribution Company's or ..."  
This comment was submitted by Mike Shepard and clarifies the intent of the statement.
6. Under Purpose on Page 4 of the CSA User's Guide rewrite the beginning of the second sentence labeled with a number (4.) as follows:  
"For parties that either primarily sell gas (i.e. producers) or primarily buy gas (i.e. Local Distribution Companies and End-Users) the current credit support provision of the Base Contract (Section 10.1) should be adequate for such purposes between the counter parties for the specific Base Contract. Further, a CSA to the Base Contract ...."  
This rewrite is in response to comment submitted by Mike Shepard and clarifies the parties that should find the Base Contract provisions on adequate security sufficient for their needs.
