

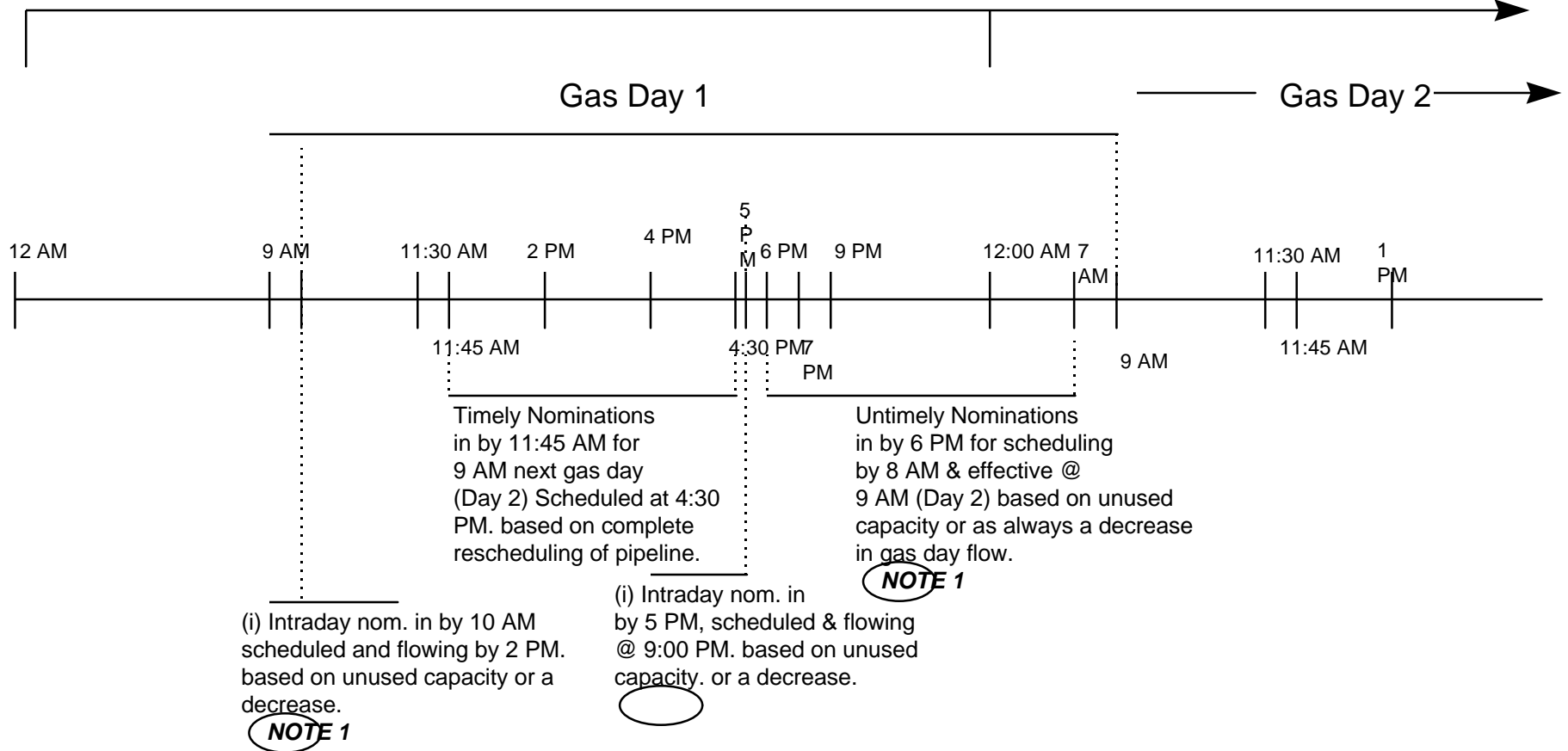

Intraday Nomination Task Force

The above nomination opportunities represent times which a shipper can expect to be supported by TSP's for synchronization across the North American pipeline network (GRID).

"Unused" capacity means additional pipeline capacity available for scheduling as determined by the TSP.
(next slide)

NOTE 1: A TSP whose tariff provisions allow for bumping could choose no less than a two hour notice period, i.e. 8:00AM, to permit a bumped party to renominate by 10:00AM an intraday for gas flow rescheduling by 2:00PM ; or the same applies to no later than a 3:00PM notice to meet the 5:00PM by 9:00PM intraday window.

A bumping party requesting capacity for either 9:00AM or 2:00PM is obliged to wait until 2:00PM or 9:00PM, respectively, to get firm space unless the TSP can accommodate earlier hourly flows while waiting for bumped party to renominate.(This very specifically means no bumping at 9:00AM.)

- **PS.** There are other issues that must be answered as well. Please come prepared on June 13 to address these.
- How many is one intraday nomination?
- Do we allow a multi-day intraday nom with a date range in the untimely category, so called Type III?
- Are three intraday batches enough?
- Does a first come/first serve process exceed the standard as long as the TSP can match with a batch TSP at 9:00am, 2:00pm & 9:00pm?
- Can you submit an intraday for 9:00pm flow time as early as 1:00pm the day before for the first batch processing or are intraday effective times processed sequential only?
- Should a bumping TSP bump more than once in a day?
