The Midwest ISO is in agreement with the proposed changes to the definitions of ancillary services in response to Commissioner Wellinghoff's request to revise the definitions to make clear that, if qualified, ancillary services may be provided from non-generation based resources. These proposed changes are in line with the Midwest ISO's proposed Energy and Ancillary Services Market, scheduled for start-up on September 9, 2008, which allows Demand Response Resources -Type II (behind-the-meter generation and/or controllable load) to provide Regulation, Spinning Reserve and/or Supplemental Reserve service, Demand Response Resources -Type I (interruptible load) to provide Supplemental Reserve service (Regional Entity Reliability Standards currently restrict Demand Response Resources -Type I from providing Spinning Reserve) and Stored Energy Resources to provide Regulation, Spinning Reserve and/or Supplemental Reserve service.
