**Subject:** NAESB Prepares M&V Standards for Wholesale Electric Market Demand Response Products and Services

On Friday April 17, the North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) the measurement and verification standards for wholesale electric market demand response products and services - [http://www.naesb.org/pdf4/ferc041709\\_dsm\\_filing.pdf](http://www.naesb.org/pdf4/ferc041709_dsm_filing.pdf). We want to thank all who contributed to this work product which includes 40 definitions and 31 business practices.

Our next DSM-EE subcommittee meeting which include both wholesale and retail market interests is scheduled for May 29 in Richmond, Virginia hosted by Dominion. We would urge you to attend either in person or by phone/web cast. In addition, we have two very active working groups that you can join. The wholesale work group is focused on the next layer of granularity for these standards -- the development of the more technical M&V standards to augment the work just completed. The retail work group is nearing completion on its first set of standards, which are complementary to the wholesale product just completed, and include regional and state characteristics.
