NAESB PUBLIC KEY INFRASTRUCTURE (PKI) IMPLEMENTATION WEB CAST COURSE

This course is designed to provide an overview of the NAESB Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) standards and other related standards that were adopted by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) through FERC Order No. 676-H and ways your company may implement the standards in compliance with the Order. The Order requires that all jurisdictional entities using the Open Access Same-time Information System (OASIS) in the wholesale electric market use PKI security on those systems and adhere to the NAESB Wholesale Electric Quadrant (WEQ) Public Key Infrastructure Business Practice Standards (WEQ-012) and other related standards. The purpose of the web course is to highlight how the WEQ-012 and related standards work with the NAESB Accreditation Requirements for Authorized Certification Authorities Specification and the NAESB Accreditation Requirements for Authorized Certification Authorities for implementation:
