UNDERSTANDING THE NAESB WGQ CONTRACTS WEB CAST COURSE

The course is designed to review the NAESB Base Contract for the Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas (WGQ Standard No. 6.3.1) and provide the attendees with a detailed understanding of the components of the contract and supporting Canadian Addendum. The agenda for the web course will include the Trading Partner Agreement (Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Overview, Provisions, and Exhibit) as well as, a brief overview of each of the other six WGQ contracts. The web course will wrap-up with development efforts underway regarding the NAESB Contracts
