To the Chairs and Members of the NAESB WEQ BPS Subcommittee:

Attached is the response from the NAESB Managing Committee on the scope question regarding two-tier curtailment. As stated in the response, the MC made the determination that the work being performed by the BPS is “within NAESB scope.” In addition, the MC has directed all Subcommittees as well as the Executive Committee to forego any discussions of FERC policy stating that doing so “is not within the competence of any NAESB committee or subcommittee.” (Please see MC response for more clarification).
