2. New Requests

R02007

Request: Submitted by Tennessee Gas Pipeline to add a new data element "Notes Code" and two related codes to the Invoicing data set, NAESB Standard No. 3.4.1.

Discussion: Mr. Gracey reviewed the request. There was no discussion.

Triage Recommendation: Triage recommendation is that it applies to the wholesale gas quadrant and it is within scope. The request should be sent to the BPS to be addressed in the normal course of business.

R02008

Request: CMS Panhandle Pipeline Companies request new Transaction Types in the Nomination (1.4.1) and Scheduled Quantity (1.4.5) data sets. The codes requested will more accurately reflect the Transaction Type codes used in the existing system during the nomination process. Service Requesters will be able to more accurately reflect the purpose of the nomination line item being submitted. It is recommended that the code values for the Transaction Type data element are:

- Authorized Firm Contract Overrun -- Firm transportation which exceeds contract capacity rights for which authorization has been granted, and
- Authorized Interruptible Contract Overrun -- Interruptible transportation which exceeds contract capacity rights for which authorization has been granted, and
- Operational Balancing Agreement -- Used to signify a type of agreement, and
- Pool Balancing -- A nomination to balance a pool.

Discussion: Ms. Van Pelt reviewed the request. There was no discussion.

Request: Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line requests new Reduction Reasons for the Scheduled Quantity (1.4.5) and Scheduled Quantity for Operator (1.4.6). The codes requested will be used to notify the service requester and/or operator of the reason for a scheduled quantity reduction. The new reduction reasons recommended are:

- Downstream Operator has not taken the gas although the gas was confirmed, and
- Upstream Operator has not taken the gas although the gas was confirmed.
