## Principles

- <u>Safety</u>: Avoid high-risk activities associated with Gas Day flow changes during the low point in the circadian alertness period (2 to 5 AM)—PHMSA Control Room Management fatigue issue
- <u>Reliability</u>: Start Gas Day when there is operating flexibility to manage flow changes. A 2 AM (PT)
  Gas Day start is the time of least operating flexibility



Gas Day at 7 AM CT (but open to regional Gas Days)

- Nominations no earlier than 9 AM CT to allow morning trading to occur during business hours
- 4 hours from Nomination Deadline to Scheduled Quantity Report for Timely Cycle; 3 hours for remaining cycles
- 1 hour between Scheduled Quantity Report and next cycle Nomination Deadline
- 4 Intraday cycles with last cycle No Bump
